1st Reading: Acts 2:1-11 **Psalm:** 103:1.24.29-31.34

R: Send forth your Spirit, O Lord, and renew the face of the earth.

Dear friends,

Today we celebrate the birthday of the Church. When the Holy Spirit came down upon the apostles he transformed them from weak and fearful people into persons of courage and confidence. It is a transformation we still celebrate, perhaps especially with the sacrament of Confirmation, in which young people take on for themselves the faith proclaimed for them by their parents at their baptism. It is true that the "going forth" of young people today is often not along the lines we see evidenced in the apostles. They certainly "go forth" but in many cases do not come back. If they are witnesses to the God they have just declared, it is less clear to those who look on. We remind ourselves of Our Lord's words on those who sow and those who reap, but it is only human to look for some signs of successful sowing. When we cannot see such signs we place a lot of trust in God that he knows what he is doing and also in our young people that they have the core values that will help them deal creatively and well with the world in all its rich mystery. It is changing so rapidly that the survival skills we have used may need to be radically changed and adapted to live positively in this brave new world. It is the Spirit, blowing where he wills, that lies at the heart of all our actions. *Fr John*
